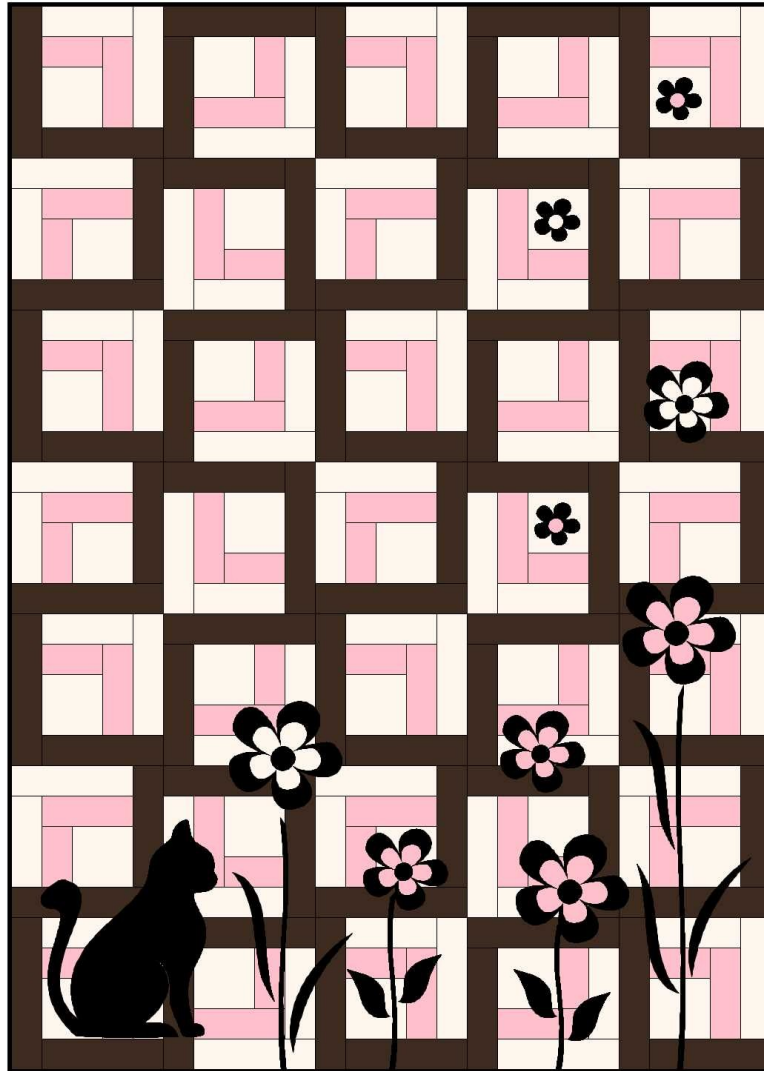




GARDEN CAT QUILT

Finished Quilt Size: 50" x 70"

Finished Block Size: 10"

Cutting instructions include 1/4" seam allowances for blocks. Be sure to read through the instructions before beginning.

Tool Requirements

Rotary Cutter and mat

24" quilting ruler

Scissors

1 yard Lite Steam-A-Seam2

Iron

Fabric Requirements

One Jelly Roll (2 1/2" wide)

From 42" wide fabric

- 2 yards Cream

- 3/4 yard Plain Black for appliqué

- fat quarter Pink appliqué flowers

- 4 1/2 yards for backing & binding

- batting 60" x 80"

- thread of your choice

Appliqués are sewn on using the raw edge method.

Block Cutting Instructions

From Cream

(35) 4½" centre square **1**

(35) 6½" x 2½" strip **4**

(35) 8½" x 2½" strip **5**

From Jelly Roll

(35) 4½" x 2½" strip **2**

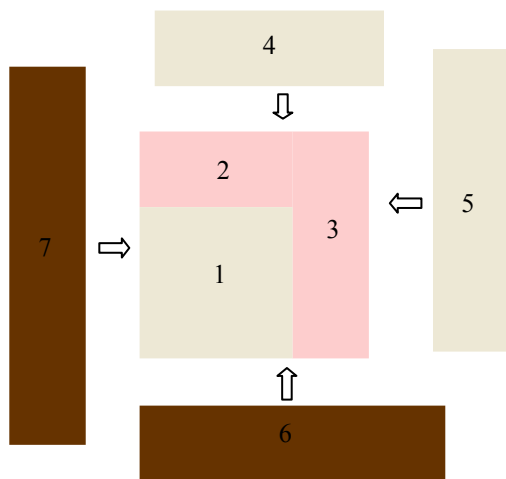
(35) 6½" x 2½" strip **3**

(35) 8½" x 2½" strip **6**

(35) 10½" x 2½" strip **7**

Step 1 Make block

Following the piecing diagram below make up 35 blocks.



Step 2 Quilt Assembly

Layout blocks into rows as per diagram on the right. Sew blocks together in rows. Sew rows together to create quilt background.

Step 3 Appliqué

Enlarge appliqué shapes to desired size. Below are the sizes I used. Each flower is made from the same flower template but in different sizes.

Cat: 15" tall

Large flower: 8"

Medium Flower: 6½"

Small Flower: 3"

Leaves and stems to desired size.

You will need to make:

1 Cat

3 Large flowers

3 Medium flowers

3 Small flowers

9 Leaves of your choice

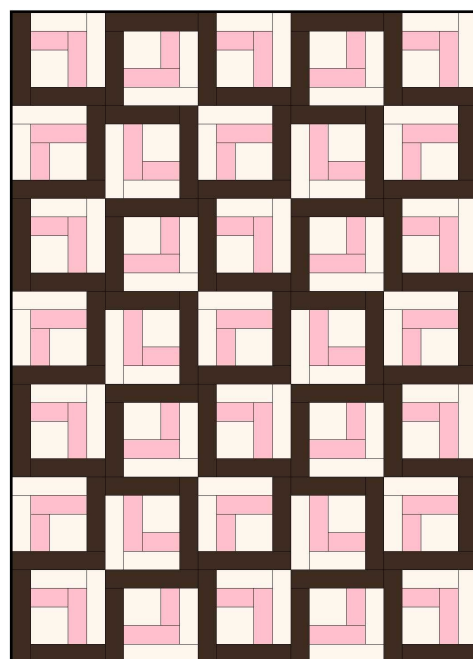
4 Stalks

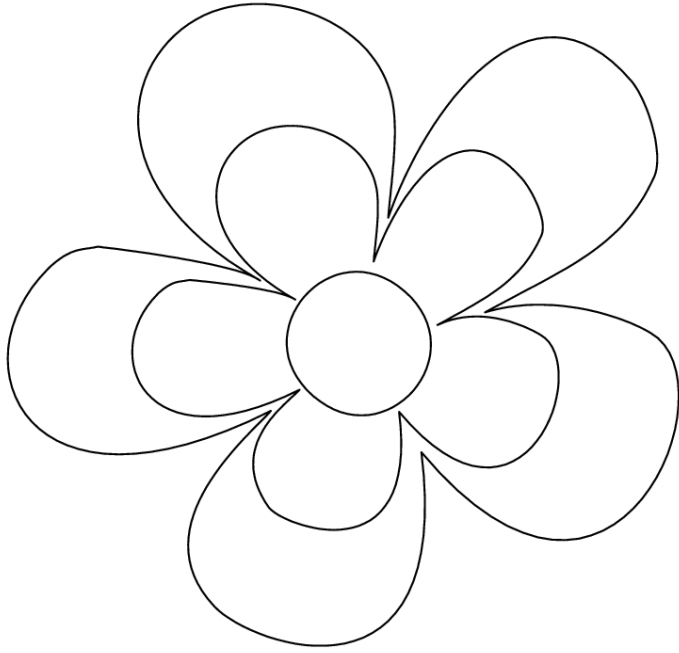
- Trace appliqué patterns onto fusible web following manufacturers instructions.
- Position traced uncut patterns onto the wrong side of fabric and iron.
- Cut out appliqué along lines.
- Peel off paper and position appliqué on quilt.
- Press appliqué in place.
- Stitch around each appliqué using matching thread and stitch of your choice.

Step 4 Finishing

Layer backing, batting and quilt top together and quilt using your preferred method.

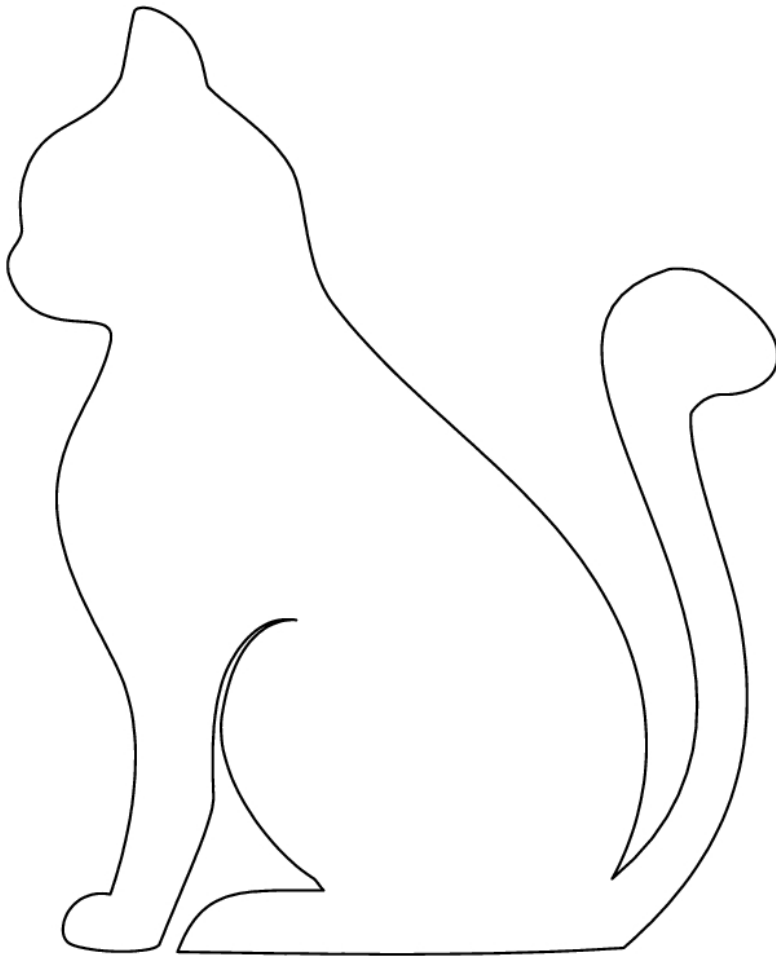
Cut 2 ½" wide binding strips and sew together to form a continuous strip. Iron in half lengthwise and sew on quilt using your preferred method.

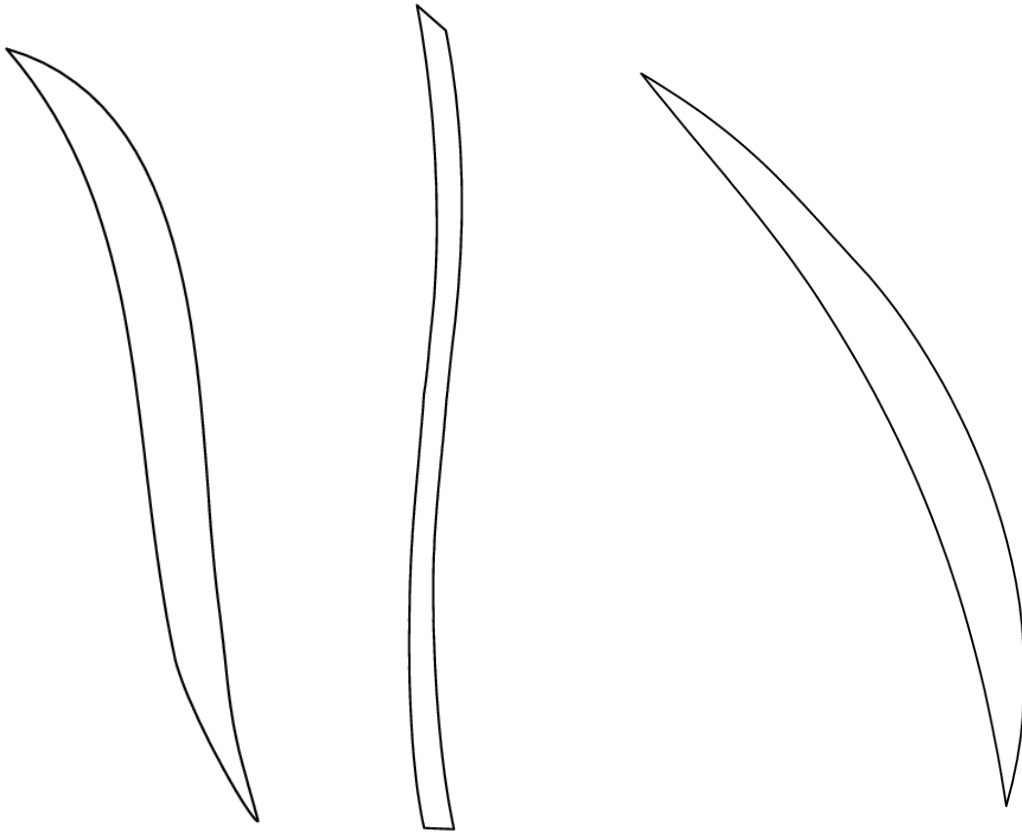
